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Making a ‘Subject Access Request’ Or, asking to see the information we hold about you.

All adults (and Children aged 12 and over) have a right to ask to see all of the personal information we have about them, including any clinical or health records their Practitioner has written.

If you would like to see any of the information we hold about you, please just ask any member of our team by email, on the telephone or in person. You do not need to use a special form or write a formal letter. We will need a clear indication of what it is you would like to see in particular. Your Therapist/Practitioner will then be made aware of your request, along with our Data Controller (Steve Holmes). We will always respond to your request in writing within one month (although often earlier whenever we can) although we may require proof of your identity before doing so.
